Don Reed was named President and Chief Executive Officer of Templeton Management Limited in 1989, and carried on that role through Templeton's acquisition by Franklin Resources Inc., and the change of company name to Franklin Templeton Investments Corp. Mr. Reed is a Director of Templeton Worldwide, Inc. and serves on the Executive Committee of Franklin Resources, Inc. In addition to managing international portfolios, including institutional accounts, Mr. Reed is also Lead Manager of Templeton International Stock Fund.

Prior to joining Templeton, Mr. Reed was President and Director of Reed Monahan Nicolishen Investment Counsel, an investment manager. Mr. Reed has been active with the Financial Analysts Federation since first elected as a Director in 1985 and is a co-founder of the International Society of Financial Analysts. He is also a Chartered Investment Counsellor and serves on the Women in Capital Markets Advisory Board. In 2000, Mr. Reed was awarded the "Thomas L. Hansberger Award for Leadership in Global Investing".
