

Student Life Committee Terms of Reference

(Approved by the Board on 1 October 2004; amended by the Board on 12 May 2007, 12 October 2007, 1 February 2008, 28 August 2010, and 4 February 2012)

Purpose

The purpose of the Student Life Committee is to underscore the importance of the learning environment and the quality of campus life as critical dimensions of the student experience and to ensure that both continue to be fundamental considerations in all Board deliberations.

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Composition

The Student Life Committee shall consist of 6 members, at least two of whom shall be student Governors. The University's Vice-President Enrolment and Student Services; Senior Director, Student Affairs, and Manager, Student Support shall serve on the Committee in an ex-officio resource (non-voting) capacity.

Frequency of Meetings

A minimum of four meetings will be held throughout the annual term in order to fulfill committee responsibilities.

Responsibilities

1. Provide policy guidance to the Board by reviewing and assessing proposed Board policies for impact on student life.
2. Develop policies and practices that will enhance the development of the campus as a collegiate community.
3. Monitor progress of the Board and University Administration in addressing student issues and needs.
4. Report to the Board with regular updates outlining current student issues and changing needs.
