David McMullin is currently Instructor in the Department of Earth and Environmental Science. Born and raised in Ireland, David first came to Acadia as an MSc student in 1982. He subsequently went to UBC where he received his PhD in Theoretical and Applied Metamorphic Petrology in 1991. He returned to Acadia in 1990 as a post-doctoral fellow.
