



Sandra Greer serves on the Board of Directors of Nova Scotia Power, Amirix Systems Inc., Nova Scotia Business Inc., COVE (Centre for Ocean Ventures and Entrepreneurship) and is on the Board of Governors of Acadia University. She was the President and CEO of Amirix Systems Inc. from March 2002 to November 2012. While at Amirix, Ms. Greer led the transformation of the organization from an R&D services company to a product one through the acquisition of Vemco, a world leader in the design and manufacture of bio-logging products for aquatic animal tracking. The successful merger of the two companies led to improved product lines and significant growth. Before Amirix Sandra's career was predominantly in telecommunications.
